Did You Know?

A tap that drips a mere six drops per minute will lose 1200L of water per year.

That is seven bath tubs down the drain.

Regular checks and maintenance for leaking taps and running toilets could save you dollars \$\$\$\$

TIP: How to check if your toilet is running.

Use food colouring to dye the water in the toilet's holding tank. If after 20 minutes the dye enters the bowl (without flushing), you have a leak
