A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF THORSBY, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ADOPTING THE INTERMUNICIPAL COLLABORATION FRAMEWORK BETWEEN LEDUC COUNTY AND THE TOWN OF THORSBY.

WHEREAS Section 708.28 (1) of the *Municipal Government Act*, being Chapter M-26 of the Statutes of Alberta, as amended, states that municipalities that have common boundaries must create a framework with each other; and

WHEREAS The Town of Thorsby and Leduc County have worked collaboratively on the preparation of an intermunicipal collaboration framework between both municipalities; and

WHEREAS Leduc County Council deems it desirable and appropriate to adopt the Intermunicipal Collaboration Framework Between Leduc County and the Town of Thorsby

**NOW THEREFORE,**


be it resolved that the Council of the Town of Thorsby, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:
