

**VILLAGE OF THORSBY
BYLAW #2012-03**

**A BYLAW IN THE VILLAGE OF THORSBY, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA FOR
THE PURPOSE OF REGULATING PROCEDURES OF ELECTING MAYOR AND
COUNCIL.**

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Government Act being Chapter M-26, R.S.A. 2000; and the Local Authorities Election Act being Chapter L-21 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 2000; and amendments thereto;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Village of Thorsby duly assembled, hereby enact as follows:

1. TITLES

- A. Chief Elected Official is to have the title of "Mayor".
- B. Councillors for the Village of Thorsby are to have the title of "Councillor".

2. NUMBER OF MEMBERS FORMING COUNCIL

- A. The number of elected members for the Village of Thorsby shall be five; one Mayor and four Councillors.

3. PROCESS OF ELECTION

- A. The election of Mayor is to be by a vote of the whole municipality with the Local Authorities Election Act applying to the election process.
- B. The election of Councillors is to be by a vote of the whole municipality with the Local Authorities Election Act applying to the election process.

This bylaw shall come into effect on the date of the next general election.

READ A SECOND TIME THIS 24 DAY OF April, 2012

READ A THIRD AND FINAL TIME THIS 8 DAY OF May, 2012
