

VILLAGE OF THORSBY
BY-LAW 2004-06

**BEING A BY-LAW OF THE VILLAGE OF THORSBY, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA
TO REPEAL BY-LAW 97-06.**

WHEREAS pursuant to section 145 of the Municipal Government Act as amended, being Chapter M-26, Statutes of Alberta, 2000, Council may pass a By-law for municipal purposes respecting the safety, health and welfare of people, and the protection of people and property, and

WHEREAS the power to pass a bylaw under the Municipal Government Act includes a power to amend or repeal the bylaw, and

NOW THEREFORE, The Council of the Village of Thorsby, in the province of Alberta duly assembled enacts as follows:

Bylaw 97-06 is hereby repealed.

READ A FIRST TIME THIS 13TH DAY OF APRIL, 2004.

READ A SECOND TIME THIS 13TH DAY OF APRIL, 2004.

READ A THIRD TIME AND PASSED THIS 13TH DAY OF APRIL, 2004.
