A BY-LAW OF THE VILLAGE OF THORSBY IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA FOR THE PURPOSE OF CLOSING AND SELLING A PORTION OF PUBLIC ROAD IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 22 OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT ACT, R.S.A. 2000, C. M-26 AS AMENDED.

WHEREAS the lands hereafter described are no longer required for public travel, and

WHEREAS application has been made to the Village Council to have the road closed and sold, and

WHEREAS notice of intention of Council to pass a by-law has been advertised in the Thorsby Target, and

WHEREAS Council provided an opportunity for those claiming to be affected prejudicially by the by-law to be heard by Council at a regular meeting, and

NOW THEREFORE be it resolved that the Council of the Village of Thorsby does hereby close the following described road subject to rights of access granted by other legislation or regulations:

Plan 3859 TR, all of lane (SW ¼ 14-49-1 W5M) excepting thereout all mines and minerals.
