

VILLAGE OF THORSBY
BY-LAW 2002-11

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND LAND USE BYLAW 2000-05 AND REPEAL BYLAW
2002-07.

PURSUANT to part 17 of the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A. 2000, C. M-26 as amended, the Council of the Village of Thorsby hereby enacts the following:

1. Village of Thorsby Bylaw 2002-07 is repealed.
2. Village of Thorsby Bylaw 2000-05, the Land Use Bylaw, is amended as follows:
 - a) Lots 19 to 20 inclusive, in Block 14, Plan 5162 TR, municipally known as 4919-46th Street and 4925-46th Street, are reclassified from R1 Low Density Residential to R3 High Density Residential.
 - b) The map forming schedule C of the bylaw is amended accordingly.
3. This By-law comes into effect on the date of third reading.
