

VILLAGE OF THORSBY

BY-LAW 96-08

A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF THORSBY IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO AUTHORIZE THE PROVISION OF PROVINCIAL E-911 SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED TO THE VILLAGE OF THORSBY.

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Section 54 of the Municipal Government Act, a municipality may provide any service or thing that is provided in all or part of the municipality in another municipal authority with the agreement of the other municipal authority.

AND WHEREAS, Pursuant to Section 7 of the Municipal Government Act, a Council may pass bylaws for municipal purposes respecting the safety, health and welfare of people and the protection of people and property.

AND WHEREAS, The Village of Thorsby Council wishes to provide Provincial E-911 service within the Municipality and enter into agreements with other agencies and/or municipalities to provide such service.


NOW THEREFORE, The Council of the Village of Thorsby duly assembled and acts as follows:

- 1 The Village of Thorsby will enter into an agreement with AGT Ltd. to provide access to emergency services via its Provincial E-911 service.
- 2 The Village of Thorsby will enter into an agreement with the Strathcona County to provide the E-911 Call Answer Services
3. The Village of Thorsby will enter into an agreement with AGT Ltd. in order that AGT will act as a billing and collecting agent for the Call Answer Service.
4. A customer within the Village of Thorsby who subscribes to AGT's Exchange Service will be provided with the E-911 service and be required to pay fees for said service.
5. This By-law shall take effect on the day of its final passing thereof.
