BY-LAW 95-04

A BY-LAW OF THE VILLAGE OF THORSBY IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA FOR THE PURPOSE OF CHARGING A FEE FOR THE PROVISION OF FIRE INSPECTION, FIRE INVESTIGATION SERVICES AND EMERGENCY INCIDENTS INVOLVING DANGEROUS GOODS.

WHEREAS pursuant to the provisions of the Safety Codes Act, Statutes of Alberta, 1991, Chapter S-0.5 with amendments in force as of September 1, 1993;

AND WHEREAS the Village of Thorsby considers it beneficial to enter into an agreement with certain other municipalities for the purpose of fire inspection, fire investigation and dangerous goods emergency control services within the Village, AND

THEREFORE that the person(s) for whom this service is provided be billed in accordance with schedule 'A' as attached to and forming part of this By-law.

This By-law shall come into effect on the date of third reading.

READ A FIRST, SECOND AND THIRD TIME THIS 8TH DAY OF MAY, A.D. 1995.

SCHEDULE 'A'

1. Response to a Fire or Emergency Incident Involving Dangerous Goods.

\$350.00 per hour or major fraction thereof per fully manned apparatus from time of response until time apparatus is returned to service, exclusive of command vehicles.

Cost for replacement of equipment and/or materials used, lost or damaged as a result of the response along with actual costs for mutual aid assistance and/or rental of additional trucks or equipment.

2. Fire Inspection Services

\$35.00 per hour plus \$.30/km

3. Fire Investigation Services

\$35.00 per hour plus \$.30/km
