

VILLAGE OF THORSBY
BY-LAW 95-02

A BY-LAW OF THE VILLAGE OF THORSBY IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA FOR THE PURPOSE OF CLOSING AND LEASING A PORTION OF PUBLIC ROAD IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 22 OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT ACT, CHAPTER M-26.1 OF THE REVISED STATUTES OF ALBERTA 1994 AND AMENDMENTS THERETO.

WHEREAS the lands hereafter described are no longer required for public travel, and

WHEREAS application has been made to the Village Council to have the road closed and leased. and

WHEREAS notice of intention of Council to pass a by-law has been advertised in the Thorsby Target on April 29, 1995 and posted at the Village office. and

WHEREAS Council provided an opportunity for those claiming to be affected prejudicially by the by-law to be heard by Council at its regular meeting on May 8, 1995. and


NOW THEREFORE be it resolved that the Council of the Village of Thorsby does hereby close the following described road subject to rights of access granted by other legislation or regulations:

All that portion of 47th Avenue east of 50th (Centre) Street to the west boundary of Lot 7, Block 20, Plan 802.0010
