

VILLAGE OF THORSBY

BY-LAW 94-08

A BY-LAW OF THE VILLAGE OF THORSBY IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTION OF A MASTER AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE VILLAGE OF THORSBY AND OTHER MUNICIPALITIES FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF AN INTER-MUNICIPAL PLANNING AGENCY

WHEREAS section 113 of the Municipal Government Act, RSA 1980 allows a municipality to enter into an agreement with other municipalities for the performance of any matter or thing judged to be of benefit to them.

AND WHEREAS the Village of Thorsby considers it beneficial to enter into an agreement with certain other municipalities for the provision of land use planning services;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Village of Thorsby in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, hereby enact as follows.

1. The Master Agreement establishing the Battle River Planning Agency, a copy of which is attached hereto, is hereby ratified and approved; and the Mayor and the Municipal Secretary are hereby authorized to execute the said agreement for and on behalf of the village of Thorsby.
2. This bylaw shall come into effect on the date of third reading.
