

VILLAGE OF THORSBY

BY-LAW NO. 93-14

BEING A BY-LAW OF THE VILLAGE OF THORSBY, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO AUTHORIZE THE ASSESSMENT OF AND LEVYING OF TAXES AGAINST THE THORSBY AGRICULTURAL SOCIETY - HAYMAKER CENTRE, ADMINISTERED UNDER THE AGRICULTURAL SOCIETIES ACT.

WHEREAS Section 25 (1) (a) of the Municipal Taxation Act, being Chapter M-31 R.S.A. 1980 and amendments thereto authorizes a municipality, by By-Law, to assess the land held by and for the use of any Agricultural Society, organized or formed under the Agricultural Societies Act together with any improvements on it and so held and used;

AND WHEREAS, Section 25 (2) of the Municipal Taxation Act makes the said Haymaker Centre liable to the levy of a tax for all purposes referred to in Section 93 of the Municipal Taxation Act;

AND WHEREAS, The Thorsby Agricultural Society owns the Haymaker Centre, administered under the Agricultural Societies Act, situated on land described as Plan 9320369, Block 21, Thorsby;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Village of Thorsby, in the Province of Alberta enacts as follows:

THAT:

1. Pursuant to Section 25 (1) (a) of the Municipal Taxation Act, the Thorsby Agricultural Society, its successors and assigns, be assessed for taxation purposes on the land and improvements situated at Plan 9320369, Block 21, Thorsby.
2. Pursuant to Section 25 (2) of the Municipal Taxation Act, the Thorsby Agricultural Society, its successors and assigns, be levied a tax for all purposes referred to in Section 93 of the Municipal Taxation Act with reference to the property described in Subsection 1, with the exception of those items listed in Section 93 (1) (d) the requisition by the board of any school division or school district. (f) the requisition by the board of any hospital district. (g) subject to the Property Tax Reduction Act, the requisition of the Government pursuant to the School Act, and (h) any other sums which the municipality becomes liable to pay by virtue of any other Act.
3. This By-Law shall have effect for the 1994 and subsequent taxation years.

READ a first, second, and third time this 13th day of December, 1993.
