

A BY-LAW OF THE VILLAGE OF THORSBY, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO PROVIDE FOR THE ENTERING INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE COUNTY OF LEDUC #25, AND THE SUMMER VILLAGES OF ARGENTIA BEACH, GOLDEN DAYS, ITASKA BEACH AND SUNDANCE BEACH FOR THE JOINT CONSTRUCTION, OWNERSHIP, MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION OF A SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT AND DISPOSAL SYSTEM.

WHEREAS Section 113 of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26 R.S.A. 1980 and Amendments thereto, provides that:

- (1) A Council may pass a By-Law authorizing the making of an agreement with the Council of any other municipality for the joint construction, ownership, maintenance, operation or use of a public work or for the performance of any other matter considered by all the Councils to be a benefit to their respective municipalities; and
- (2) The Council may in the By-Law appoint one or more of its members to be members of a joint committee with members appointed by the Councils of other municipalities and may delegate to such joint committee power to construct, maintain, control and manage such undertaking, including the power to disburse the proceeds of debenture or other funds used for the purpose of such undertaking; and


WHEREAS the Municipalities by an Agreement in writing dated the 11th day of May, A.D., 1983 provided for a joint study being undertaken as to the feasibility of a regional sanitary landfill being established to serve the Village of Thorsby, the Summer Villages of Argentia Beach, Golden Days, Itaska Beach and Sundance Beach and a portion of the County of Leduc No. 25; and

WHEREAS the Councils of the Village of Thorsby and the Summer Villages of Argentia Beach, Golden Days, Itaska Beach and Sundance Beach and the County of Leduc No. 25 (hereinafter collectively referred to as "the Municipalities") consider it to be a benefit to their respective municipalities to arrange for and provide a solid waste management and disposal system for their residents within a certain defined area of the Municipalities (hereinafter referred to as "the Service Area");

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Section 113 of The Municipal Government Act the Council of the Village of Thorsby enact as follows:

- (1) THAT the Village of Thorsby shall forthwith enter into an Agreement with the County of Leduc #25, and the Summer Villages of Argentia Beach, Golden Days, Itaska Beach and Sundance Beach, for the joint construction, ownership, maintenance, operation and use of a solid waste management and disposal system to service the Service Area, such Agreement to be in the form of the Agreement attached to this By-Law as Schedule "A" and that the Mayor and the Administrator are hereby authorized and instructed to execute the said Agreement under the corporate seal of the Village of Thorsby.
- (2) THAT one member of Council, or an alternate or alternates appointed by resolution of Council, shall be a member for the Village of Thorsby of a joint committee together with a member from each of the other Municipalities, which committee shall be designated and known as The Thorsby and Area Regional Sanitary Landfill Authority.
- (3) THAT the authority to construct, maintain, control and manage the solid waste management and disposal system is hereby delegated to The Thorsby and Area Regional Sanitary Landfill Authority in accordance with the provisions contained in the Agreement attached as Schedule "A" to this By-Law.
- (4) THAT the Thorsby and Area Regional Sanitary Landfill Authority shall have the power to disburse the proceeds of debentures or other funds used for the purpose of the solid waste management and disposal system.
