

A BYLAW of the Village of Thorsby, in the Province of Alberta to enter into an agreement with neighbouring Municipalities to establish an Ambulance Board.

Under and by Virtue conferred upon it by Sections 168, 169 and 170 of the Municipal Government Act, Revised Statutes of Alberta 1980, Chapter M-26 as amended, the Village of Thorsby enacts as follows:

That the Village of Thorsby enter into an agreement with the County of Wetaskiwin #10, Town of Calmar, City of Leduc, Village of Breton, Village of New Serepta, and Village of Warburg and representation of the Municipal Corporations duly form the Leduc and Area Ambulance Board.

The Leduc and Area Ambulance Board shall:

- a. Enter into an agreement with an ambulance operator for ambulance services.
- b. Establish the necessary Bylaws and regulations for the operations of the Board.
- c. Establish the per capita subsidy to be paid to the ambulance operator.

The said agreement shall be attached to and from Appendix "A" of this Bylaw.

The Mayor and Secretary - Treasurer shall be authorized to sign the necessary cheques, contracts, or agreements that may be necessary under the provisions of this Bylaw.
