

BYLAW 85-6

A BYLAW of the Village of Thorsby, in the Province of Alberta for the purpose of disposing of Lots P and R, Block 2, Plan 2148ET.

The purpose is to dispose of the said lands by sale, lease, or otherwise. The proceeds from the sale, lease or other disposition shall be deposited to a Municipal Reserve Account and used only for:

- (a) public park
- (b) a public recreation area
- (c) school purposes, or
- (d) to separate areas of land that are used for different purposes, in accordance with Section 117 (3) of the Planning Act.

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority conferred upon it by the Planning Act, Chapter P-9, Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1980, the Council of the Village of Thorsby, duly assembled, herein enacts as follows.

That Lots P and R, Block 2, Plan 2148ET shall be disposed of by sale, the monies to be used for a public recreation area.

Bylaw 85-6 shall come into effect on the date of the third reading and confirmation of the Registrar removing the Park designation.
