

Being a By-Law of the Village of Thorsby
to approve an Agreement pertaining to Senior Citizens Housing.

WHEREAS the Senior Citizens Housing Act, being Chapter S-17 of The Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1980, as amended, provides a means whereby low rental housing units and homes for senior citizens of the Province of Alberta may be made available in or to the municipalities thereof;

AND WHEREAS the Senior Citizens Housing Act provides for The Leduc Foundation to enter into an agreement with other municipalities and the Alberta Housing Corporation for the operation and management of Senior Citizens Homes;

AND WHEREAS the Alberta Housing Corporation of the said Province has submitted a draft copy of a proposed agreement to be entered into between The County of Leduc No. 25, The City of Leduc, The Town of Devon, The Town of Calmar, The Village of Thorsby, The Village of Warburg, The Village of Breton, The Village of New Sarepta, The Leduc Foundation and the Alberta Housing Corporation for the purpose of bringing the Planeview Manor Addition in the City of Leduc into the management portfolio of the foundation;

AND WHEREAS it is expedient that the Village of Thorsby
enter into such an agreement, being an amending agreement
to an agreement called the "Master Agreement";

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF THORSBY
ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Mayor and Secretary-Treasurer are hereby authorized to executed on behalf of the Village of Thorsby an amending agreement to the Master Agreement with the Alberta Housing Corporation and The County of Leduc No. 25, The City of Leduc, The Town of Devon, The Town of Calmar, The Village of Thorsby, The Village of Warburg, The Village of Breton, The Village of New Sarepta, The Leduc Foundation for the purpose of bringing the Planeview Manor Addition in the City of Leduc into the management portfolio of the foundation, in the form and substance of the Agreement attached to the By-Law as Schedule "A" and made part hereof.
