

VILLAGE OF THORSBY

A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF THORSBY, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, FOR THE PURPOSE OF CLOSING AND SELLING A PORTION OF A PUBLIC LANE IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTIONS 180 AND 183 OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT ACT, CHAPTER M-26, REVISED STATUTES OF ALBERTA 1980.

WHEREAS the lands hereafter described are no longer required for public travel.

WHEREAS application has been made to the Council to have the lane closed, and

WHEREAS Notice of intention of the Council to pass a bylaw has been mailed by registered mail to persons registered or assessed as owners of the land abutting upon the portion of the lane so proposed to be closed at least two weeks before the date fixed for the passing of the bylaw, and

WHEREAS Notice of intention of the Council to pass a bylaw has been published in the Representative on May 23, 1984 and May 29, 1984 the last of such publications being at least two weeks before the day fixed for the passing of the bylaw, and

WHEREAS Council was not petitioned for an opportunity to be heard by any person prejudicially affected by the Bylaw.

NOW THEREFORE Be it resolved that the Council of the Village of Thorsby does hereby close the following described lane.

That portion shown as lane in Block 4, Plan 63 H.W. lying to the north of Lot C.
