

VILLAGE OF THORSBY

BY-LAW NO. 82 - 15

A By-law regulating discharge of industrial wastewater into Village of Thorsby Sewage Treatment Facilities. This By-law may be cited as:

Industrial Wastewater By-law

WHEREAS the Village of Thorsby is in the process of constructing its new sewage treatment facilities, and

WHEREAS one of the Terms and Conditions of the Permit to Construct issued by Alberta Environment requires regulation of industrial wastewater discharge into this system,

NOW THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of the Village of Thorsby duly assembled enacts as follows:

1. No person shall discharge or cause or permit to be discharged industrial wastewater into the sanitary sewerage system, without pre-treatment of the industrial wastewater to domestic sewage strength, with a standard 5-day B.O.D. of less than 300 mg/L.
2. If the person shall neglect or refuse to comply with the above regulation for a period of 60 days after a notice in writing, a penalty of \$100 shall be imposed, and the matter referred to the Pollution Control Branch of Alberta Environment for further action.

This By-law shall become effective May 1, 1983.

Read a first time this 22 day of December, 1982.

Read a second time this 22 day of December, 1982.

Read a third time and duly passed this 22 day of December, 1982.
