

BEING a Bylaw to authorize the Municipal Council of the Village of Thorsby, in the Province of Alberta, to enter into agreements with Her Majesty the Queen in the Right of Alberta (Represented by the Minister of Environment).

WHEREAS under the provisions of Section 119, of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter 246 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1980, (as amended), the Council may pass a Bylaw authorizing the making of an agreement with the Province of Alberta, or its agents, for the performance of any matter or thing considered by the Council and the Province or its agents to be a benefit to both parties; and

WHEREAS under Section 7 of the Land Surface Conservation and Reclamation Act the Minister of Environment may enter into an agreement with an owner to restrict the use of certain land;

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Village of Thorsby, in Council assembled enacts as follows:

That the Mayor and Secretary-Treasurer of the Village of Thorsby be and are hereby empowered to execute an agreement similar to the form attached and marked Exhibit "A" between the said Town and the Minister of the Environment relating to reclamation of certain lands described as follows:

Lot B Plan 3237RS - South Lagoon
Lot C Plan 1882TR - North Lagoon
