A By-law to authorize the Municipal Council of the Village of Thorsby to enter into agreements with Her Majesty, the Queen, in the right of Alberta (represented by the Minister of the Environment).

WHEREAS under the provisions of Section 119 of The Municipal Government Act, being Chapter 246 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1970, (as amended), the Council may pass a By-law authorizing the making of an agreement with the Province of Alberta, or its agents, for the performance of any matter or thing considered by the Council and the Province or its agents to be a benefit to both parties; and

WHEREAS under the Environment Grant Regulations the Minister of the Environment may enter into an agreement with a local authority to provide for any work or undertakings; and

WHEREAS the Council of the Village of Thorsby has made application to the Minister of the Environment under the Alberta Municipal Waterworks Assistance Program for financial assistance for a project relating to the installation of a Raw Water Reservoir and Pumping Facilities in the Village of Thorsby

NOW THEREFORE THE VILLAGE OF THORSBY COUNCIL DULY ASSEMBLED ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

That the Mayor and Secretary-treasurer of the Village of Thorsby be and is hereby empowered to execute agreements similar to the form attached and marked Exhibit "A", between the said Village of Thorsby and the Minister of the Environment relating to the Alberta Municipal Waterworks Assistance Program.
