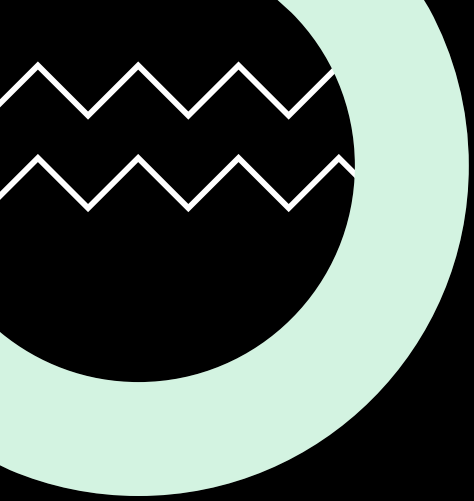

1. Regulate and control all roadways and Highway with the safety and interest of the Town's residents in mind
2. Update 2006-05 Traffic Safety bylaw
3. Include safety guidelines for bicycles, skateboarding, etc.
4. Introduce Speed Limits for School Zones & Parks
5. Clearly define and offences penalties for breaching the Bylaw.



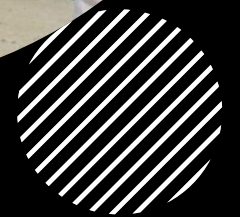

# Traffic Control Device



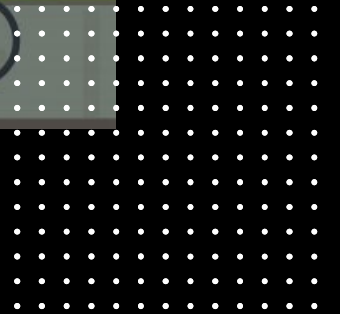
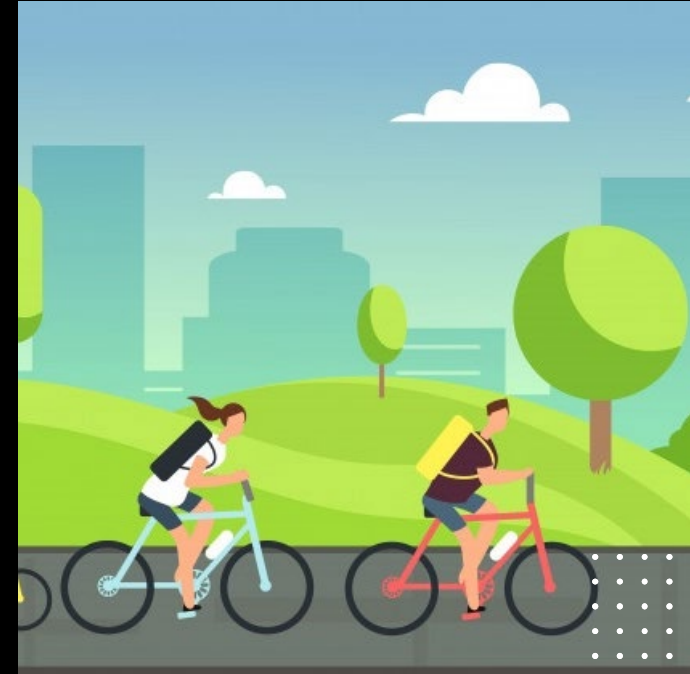
a sign, signal, marking, or device placed to warn & direct pedestrians



# Bicycle Safety

Every Person operating a Bicycle in accordance with the provisions of the Bylaw shall:

- If under the age of eighteen (18) years, wear a helmet.
- If under the age of eighteen (18) years, have a bell or other audible warning device equipped to alert others.





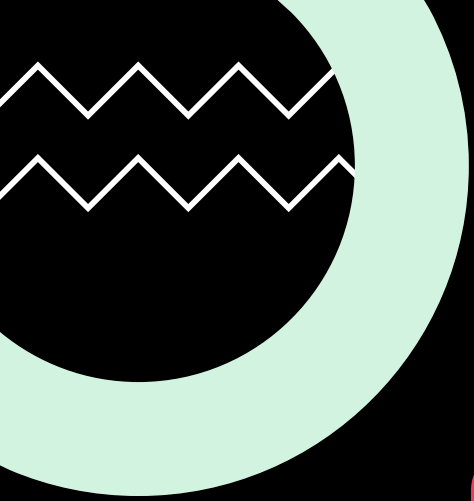
# Bicycle Safety

Every Person operating a Bicycle in accordance with the provisions of the Bylaw shall:

- Yield the right-of-way to Pedestrians.
- When passing a Pedestrian, use all due care, required to ensure the safety of a Pedestrian.
- Give an audible signal before overtaking a Pedestrian,







# Speed Limits

No person shall operate a Vehicle at a speed greater than fifty (50) kilometers per hour on any roadway within the Town

No person shall operate a Vehicle within a School Zone at any speed greater than thirty (30) kilometers per hour between the hours of 07:30 and 16:30.

No person shall operate a Vehicle within a Playground Zone at any rate of speed greater than thirty (30) kilometers per hour.
