

TOWN OF THORSBY BYLAW #2021 - 02

A BYLAW TO AUTHORIZE THE RATES OF TAXATION TO BE LEVIED AGAINST ASSESSABLE PROPERTY WITHIN THE TOWN OF THORSBY FOR THE 2021 TAXATION YEAR.

WHEREAS, the Town of Thorsby has prepared and adopted detailed estimates of municipal revenue, expenses and expenditures as required, at the council meeting held on May 11, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the estimated municipal expenditure and transfers set out in the annual budget for the Town of Thorsby for 2021 total \$3,266,662; and

WHEREAS, the estimated municipal revenues from all sources other than property taxation total \$2,375,579 and the balance of \$1,164,440 is to be raised by general municipal taxation; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Town of Thorsby is required each year to levy on the assessed value of all property, tax rates sufficient to meet the estimated expenditures and the requisitions; and

WHEREAS, the council of the Town of Thorsby is authorized to sub-classify assessed property, and to establish different rates of taxation in respect to each sub-class of property, subject to the *Municipal Government Act*, Chapter M-26, Revised Statues of Alberta, 2000; and

WHEREAS, the assessed value of all property in the Town of Thorsby as shown on the
